Helping Hands has a new name: **The Jullia Rose Foundation.** The Jullia Rose Foundation is a registered 501c nonprofit committed to helping children in need. Last year because of your donations we were able to give 29 children with autism Ipad's to help them communicate. This year we would again like to help children with special needs.

According to a study done in 2012, 49% of children with autism had attempted to wander or run away. 65% of those incidents involved a close call with traffic, and 24% involved a close call with drowning. We would like to make it possible for all of the children in our community with special needs who have a tendency to wander to wear a tracking device. If the child is wearing a tracking device, they can be found quickly, decreasing the chance of injury or death. With your donation we can bring Project Life Saver, an advanced tracking system that is currently used in other communities, to our area. If a child does wander, recovery times for Project Lifesaver agencies average 30 minutes, which is 95% less time than standard operations without Project Lifesaver. Any funds exceeding our goal will be used for items needed by children with special needs in our community.
